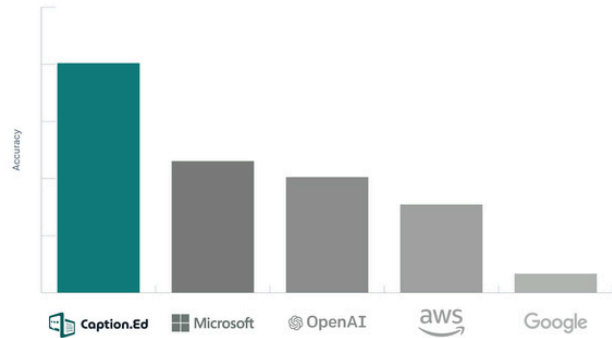

Unbelievable accuracy

When it comes to accuracy, Caption.Ed outperforms the major cloud providers including Google, Amazon, OpenAI, and Microsoft, giving users access to reliable and consistent captions.



Tests conducted in January 2023 against Microsoft Azure Video Indexer, OpenAIs Whisper (large-v2 model), Amazon Transcribe and Google Cloud Speech-to-text (latest_long model) compared to Caption.Ed's speech-to-text model

Assign speaker names

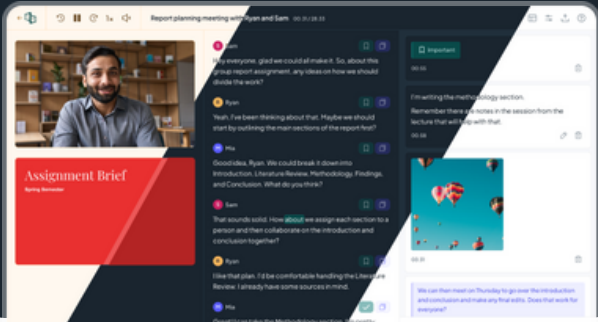

Customise Caption.Ed

Users can customise Caption.Ed to however they like it. Use shortcuts to make notes at the click of a button, switch between light, dark, or sepia mode, or even adjust the size of the captioning window.

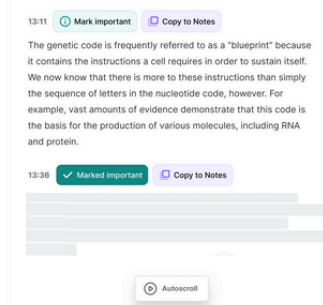
