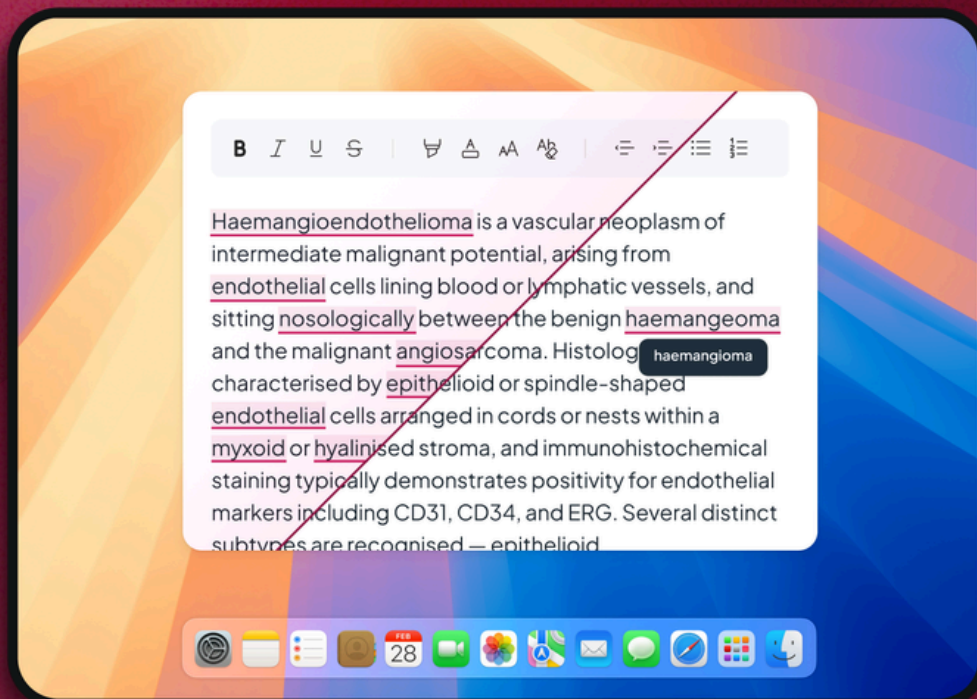

# Example Justifications

## Dyslexia (SPLD)
